Admissions Process:

Step 1.

Apply Online

Click the **'Apply'** button on our website to begin your application. You will need the following documents:

- Applicant's unabridged birth certificate
- Copy of IDs (parent/guardian/sponsor)
- Head and shoulders photo of the applicant
- Latest school report
- Proof of payment of the R800 application fee

Step 2.

Financial Documentation

Once your application is submitted, our Admissions Administrator will send you the following forms to complete:

- Financial Clearance Permission Form
- Proof of Household Income (last three months' bank statements or salary slips)
- Statement of Family Income and Expenses

Step 3.

Interview

Once financial clearance is complete, you will be invited for an interview with the Head of Epworth High School.

Step 4.

Entrance Exam

All Grade 8 applicants will be required to write an entrance exam (an English and a Mathematics paper) at the beginning of Term 2, 2027 (further information regarding the dates and details of this will be sent to all applicants in the first term of 2027. These assessments are skills-based rather than content-based and, together with applicants' end of Grade 6 report, assists us with benchmarking all our Grade 8 applicants.

Step 5.

Offer of a Place

All offers of places, scholarships and fellowships for Grade 8, 2028 will take place on **Friday, 12 March 2027**.

If your daughter's application is successful, you will receive:

- An official **offer of place**
- A **school contract**
- Details of the **acceptance fee (10% of annual tuition fees and an additional 10% of boarding fees for boarder applicants)**, which will be due by the given deadline

If we cannot offer you a place or space is not available, your daughter may be placed on a waiting list.

Step 6.

Further Communication and Welcome Pack

In the second half of 2027, and after submitting the signed contract and paying your acceptance fee, you will receive:

- Parent/pupil handbook
- Uniform and stationery information
- Orientation programme information
